The general education requirement for our college includes a course on “Cultural Values and Global Issues.” During the Fall 2007 semester, I initiated a course titled Ethnomathematics to fill this requirement. Because this was presented as a general education course rather than a mathematics course, enrollment included freshmen to seniors, from a wide range of disciplines. One objective of the course was to help students begin to develop connections between different cultures, including their own, through the lens of mathematical thinking.
