Hanne Darboven was a German conceptual artist who used the physical act of writing—words, numbers, patterns—as both representation and actualization of time. In works such as *Month III* (1974), she juxtaposed symbolic, physical and graphical representations of each day, using “checksums” to encapsulate the dates. In this talk we will look at a number of her works, relating them both to those of other conceptual artists, as well as mathematical practices such as check digits. We will also explore a number of simple mathematical problems arising from her methods that are applicable to the classroom. (Received September 25, 2018)
