This will be a report on the author's experiences implementing IBL techniques for the first time in Calculus III and Introduction to Statistics classes during the Fall 2018 semester at Southwestern University - a small, private 4-year liberal arts university in Central Texas. At the time this abstract was submitted, we were only about one month into the semester. But already, several positive and a few negative results have been noted. The presentation will highlight the results of the entire semester, as well as ongoing, mid-semester adjustments to the format of the classes.
