

BIG Career Center: Information for Exhibitors

January 5 – 8, 2022, Joint Mathematics Meetings, Seattle, WA

The BIG Career Center in the exhibit area of the Joint Mathematics Meetings (JMM) provides a physical space for exchange between:

- Business, Industry, and Government (BIG) employers of mathematically-trained individuals, and
- Participants inquiring about career opportunities in the exhibitors' organizations.

The JMM is the largest mathematics meeting in the world, and in 2022, it will be hosted at the Washington State Convention Center. Industry representatives who sign up for time slots at the BIG Career Center will be able to network and provide information about their organizations. They will find:

- Talented, energetic, in-training and practicing mathematical scientists
- Opportunities to ask for resumes and distribute business cards and other information
- A centrally-located, turnkey venue in the exhibit area
- Traffic from the anticipated 4,000+ JMM participants

Space in the BIG Career Center is provided during the specified times, shown below, with tables for two simultaneous exhibitors per 1-hour time slot.

1. Employers may reserve **1-hour** slots in increments beginning on the half hour, except for the slightly extended time slot of 12:15 pm – 1:30 pm on Wednesday.
2. **The cost is \$100/hr.**
3. **To request time slots at the BIG Careers Booth or obtain additional information,** email bigcareers@ams.org. Priority in fulfilling these requests will be based on the order in which they are received.
4. Once time slots have been reserved, employers will have **access to a resume book** of participants attending the Joint Mathematics Meetings. AMS staff will provide login credentials to MathJobs.org, where the resumes will be housed.

The booth will be staffed by AMS staff and volunteer personnel. Exhibitors may wish to bring small-footprint signage, a customized tablecloth, and print materials for the timeslots in which they are scheduled.
